S – Spectacular event (take whatever you do in your club and take it up a level...)

- O Orient your visitors (help them understand what we do in Toastmasters and what the benefits are)
- A Atmosphere (friendly and supportive take whatever you do in your club and take it up a level...)
- R Relationships (start building a relationship with each visitor so he or she wants to come back...)
