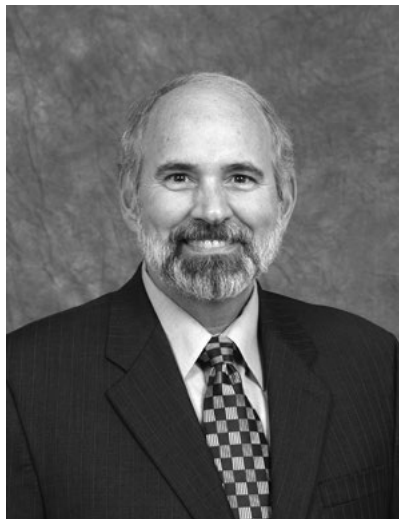


FUN-damentals: Incorporate More Enjoyment in Your Toastmasters Journey
